PARNELLI quickly sped clear, set the pace on the inside through quick fractions, was asked outside the quarter-pole, powered further ahead while cutting the corner into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker and proved much the best under a strong drive. MR. JENNEY moved in early, saved ground on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, raced off the rail

on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, dropped to the inside after turning into the stretch and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. SECRETIVE was eager in the early going, tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. ELLA'S KITTEN was well placed on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, came off the rail near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. INVINCIBLE ME was eager while towards the rear in the initial stages, raced off the rail on the first turn while settling a bit more kindly, took off again early on the backstretch, was hard held while rank inside the five-eighths pole, lowered his head again not too far after, went three wide on the second turn while behind horses, was asked at the top of the stretch, moved out inside the furlong marker and improved position without threatening. DOC CEBU saved ground on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was roused while inside on the far turn and failed to rally. BRILLIANT COMMAND saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, raced off the rail while at the back on the far turn, was driven four wide near the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. IN ROCKY'S HONOR went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. MARINE PATROL went two to three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, was roused while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. KING OF BROADWAY went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged before the half-mile pole, went four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. SAMPSON COUNTY went four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and had nothing left.
