Footnotes

PALACE settled in the early going while on the outside, came under urging with five furlongs to run, moved in leaving the backstretch, was urged along in mostly the three path on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied under a left-handed whip, closed well to get the lead near the furlong marker and drew clear under steady urging. THE LUMBER GUY came away in good order, followed the leader from second, ranged up while three wide early on the turn, took the lead with three furlongs to run, continued three wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip while in front outside the furlong marker, lost the lead to the winner shortly thereafter and tired while able to get the place. NIGHT MANEUVER was urged along on the outside while in third position, moved closer while four wide on the turn, made a bid while under a strong ride, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened while able to get the show. SPA CITY FEVER smashed open the front of the gate prior to the start, was held onto by the assistant starter then brought back around the gate and reloaded, broke out a bit but came away well, was urged along on the outside, went two to three wide on the turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, continued under the whip while getting closer in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. EVEN GOT QUIET was ridden along at the rear, saved ground on the turn, came under a right-handed whip outside the quarter-pole, switched to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and failed to threaten. N. F.'S DESTINY showed good speed, set the pace through quick fractions, was challenged while inside on the turn, dropped out at the top of the stretch and stopped.
