**Footnotes**

HERD MENTALITY tracked the pace on the outside, chose the three path on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, chased under a drive in upper stretch, gained the lead near the furlong marker, was put to a left-handed whip shortly thereafter and proved best under good handling. SPINTASTIC was hustled to the lead, set the pace through tepid fractions, vied inside on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, lost the lead near the eighth-pole, fought on for a while along the rail but was outfinished while well clear for the place. JOEY N settled off the pace, was taken up while in tight leaving the backstretch, went two to three wide early on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, moved to four wide late on the bend, came five wide into the stretch and safely secured the show. LUTESIFER settled off the pace, was urged along by the half-mile pole, went two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SERIOUSLY SHARP moved in early, was well placed just off the pace, raced on the inside while coaxed along on the turn, saved ground into the stretch, came under a drive and capitulated. OPTIONALITY was ridden along while off the pace, went four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. EL DREAMER lacked speed while ridden along on the outside, went five wide on the turn and was outrun. VOLATILE MARKETS dropped back at the start, drifted to the outside while at the rear, went six wide early on the turn then floated eight wide, drifted out at least ten wide late on the bend and was eased under restraint then walked off. ACRO'S GAME was ridden along while well back in the field, went three to four wide on the turn and faltered.
