MEDAGLIA D'ORO came away running, pressed the pace while between rivals, drew clear approaching the stretch, took a clear lead past the eighth pole, dug in determinedly when joined by REPENT in deep stretch and held off that rival under a steady drive. REPENT was outrun along the inside early, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside but could not get by the winner. NOTHING FLAT dropped back along the inside early, picked it up when asked on the second turn, rallied four wide, angled to the inside in upper stretch and offered a mild rally while no real threat to the top two. LIKE A HERO was unhurried along the inside early, angled out and rallied four wide approaching the stretch but had little left for the drive. PUZZLEMENT was outrun early while wide, put in a four wide run on the second turn but could not sustain that bid. QUEST was hustled up inside, chased the pace, put in a three wide move leaving the backstretch and tired in the drive. GOLD DOLLAR was hustled along inside and had no response when roused. SAINT MARDEN raced close up while four wide for the opening three quarters and tired. SHAH JEHAN was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired on the second turn.
