WILDCAT BETTIE B bumped at the start, steadied between horses in the early stages, trailed along the backstretch, saved ground while launching her bid on the turn, moved into contention along the rail in upper stretch, angled out in midstretch then wore down G CITY GAL to win going away. G CITY GAL rushed up along the rail, dueled heads apart along the backstretch, surged to the front at the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in midstretch, continued on the lead into deep stretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. KHALILA was outrun for a half while racing wide, circled five wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly to gain a share. CHEROKEE JEWEL raced just off the pace along the inside, angled three wide while gaining at the quarter pole, moved back to the inside in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. MISTY ROSETTE settled just behind the leaders while saving ground for a half, angled out at the quarter pole, drifted out in upper stretch, lodged a mild bid in midstretch and flattened out. SUMMER GIRLFRIEND raced in midpack while five wide to the top of the stretch and faded in the stretch. ORIGINAL SPIN set or forced the pace from outside into upper stretch and tired from her early efforts. ANY LIMIT bumped at the start, steadied between horses early, raced in traffic at the half mile pole, angled three wide on the turn and gave way in the stretch.
