SO N SO set the pace under pressure in the two path, drifted in a bit under right hand urging while opening a clear advantage in midstretch then half off the runner-up in the late stages. MINERALOGIST pressed the pace along the inside into upper stretch, steadied and altered course to the outside nearing the eighth pole then closed late from outside but could not get up. SUGAR TRADE settled just off the pace for a half, swung three wide entering the stretch and lacked a late response. SCREEN SAVIOUR failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. FRESH FOOTNOTES was taken in hand early and never reached contention. SILVER SHOES showed only brief speed.
