INCA KING was well placed behind the early leader, closed the gap on the turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch then was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the final strides. BLUES STREET raced in the middle of the pack while four wide for a half, swung five wide while gaining at the quarter pole and finished strongly in the middle of the track but could not get up. OPERATION RED DAWN steadied in traffic soon after the start, raced between horses while outrun for a half, angled five wide leaving the turn and rallied belatedly. GIMME CREDIT was outrun along the inside to the turn then closed well between horses in the final eighth. BROAD RIVER chased in the two path, lodged a bid to threaten in midstretch and weakened late. DIRGE saved ground in good position into upper stretch and lacked a late response. PRINCE RAHY raced between horses for six furlongs, swung out in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. RIVERSRUNRYLEE rushed up to gain the early advantage, led to the top of the stretch and gave way. MORE THAN A REASON was finished after going a half.
