Footnotes

STAFF SARGEANT bumped with RICKI MCD nearing the first turn, was reserved well off the pace while off the inside, came under urging with a half-mile to run, advanced while off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide approaching the quarter-pole, closed fast on the outside, drifted in under right hand urging outside the furlong marker, came in a bit more while under strong hand urging passing that marker, kicked clear and was switched to a left-handed whip then drew away under a strong drive. GRIFFIN ROCK saved ground on the first turn, settled near the back of the field, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, split rivals near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to the whip in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the place. FORTY TEARS settled off the pace, advanced inside on the far turn, moved off the rail around the five-sixteenths pole, closed well in upper stretch, steadied while making a bid between rivals entering the final furlong, failed to match the winner then was caught for the place. LAST OUT OF PANAMA bumped with a rival at the

start, bumped with CONWAY in the early going, moved to the lead while eager and under a tight hold, was hard to rate while well in front, remained clear on the far turn, was asked as the lead diminished near the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and weakened. ALVITO bobbed after the start, went three wide on the first turn, moved in on the backstretch, was roused while inside on the far turn, moved into striking range in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. CONWAY bumped with LAST OUT OF PANAMA in the early going, followed that rival in second, was taken wide near the half-mile pole, went three to four wide on the far turn and tired. NEWMAN ROCKS bumped soundly with GAELIC WEALTH in the early going, went three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, came under urging near the half-mile pole and failed to threaten. GAELIC WEALTH bumped with a rival at the start, bumped soundly with NEWMAN ROCKS in the early going, lagged well back in the field and was no factor. FU PEGS BABY came in during the early stages, brushed with STAFF SARGEANT nearing the first turn then became rank briefly, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went four wide on the far turn and came up empty. PROUD GEORGE raced three then two wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed, came up empty on the far turn and stopped. RIKI MCD bumped with STAFF SARGEANT nearing the first turn, saved ground on that turn, was through early and retreated. Following the race, the rider of FORTY TEARS claimed foul against STAFF SARGEANT for interference at the eighth-pole. After the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish.
