NO MORE FIVES broke sharply, tucked along the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, requiring the rider of SHOULD MAKE IT, in precariously close off heels now, to take the precautionary action of steadying his mount, with a slight loss of ground and momentum for that rival as a result, continued along on the rail on a loosely-contested lead, unasked for speed unlike some of her closest pursuers, headed for the lane with a comfortable advantage and got roused, began to drift noticeably towards the grandstand apron arriving at the three-sixteenths pole, continued to so despite a right handed whip from the pilot in the last eighth, held sway. GO THE DISTANCE behaved fractiously during the loading procedure, reacted to the antics of DESERT TRAVELER and broke through the gate just after that rival did, was put back in after being examined by the track veterinarian and once more after acting up a bit, proceeded to come away with no apparent mishap, resisted the rating tactics being applied by the rider for much of the initial quarter, fighting against the bit, particularly from the left side, went about more professionally on the turn however, was let out a notch and instantly picked up interest, angled three wide into the stretch and was called upon for much more, altered course to be inside the erratic winner in mid lane, tried hard but couldn't reel in the top one. STAR BLACK swung four wide into upper stretch, lacked the needed response. SHOULD MAKE IT was sent over to the inside in the opening stages, steadied off heels as the winner was crossing over just before reaching the end of the backstretch, fell back slightly with the loss of momentum, kept within striking distance around the turn, was urged while angling outward at the quarter pole, soon gave way. PURE TREASURE three wide and set down by the midway point on the turn faded steadily after completing the half. DESERT TRAVELER reared up several times then broke through the starting gate, got put back in and stumbled at the start, chased the winner from the outside for a half and tired.
