RESERVED QUALITY came away in good order, settled on the outside while under some urging, was expertly guided in near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, slipped through inside P J'S MAGICAL WINK coming to the five-sixteenths pole to take the lead, edged clear leaving the bend, responded well when given two cracks of a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip approaching the furlong marker and held well under continued right hand urging in a very nice ride. PROFESSOR FATE showed good speed between rivals then dropped just off the pace, moved in near the half-mile pole, waited behind rivals while in hand early on the turn, was beaten to the punch by the winner, came under urging at the five-sixteenths pole, angled four wide outside the quarter-pole, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip while moving into second past the sixteenth-pole and secured the place while eased up in the final strides. FUSA CODE dropped back at the start, angled in near the back of the field, raced off the rail early on the turn, dropped to the inside near the three-eighths pole, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, gained ground into the stretch, chased the winner under a left-handed whip and weakened then was overtaken for the place. DANGEROUS TRICK bobbed at the start but broke in front, lugged out while showing speed, drifted way out in the track while chasing the pace, was guided around the turn while six wide, straightened out while under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, dropped back out of contention, had the rider lose his whip near the sixteenth-pole and weakened. MATTY'S AVENGER lacked early speed while ridden along, raced three then two wide on the turn, made his way to the inside nearing the quarter-pole, raced under the whip in upper stretch and failed to rally. P J'S MAGICAL WINK showed good natural speed, set the pace through fast fractions while under pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead near the five-sixteenths pole, drifted three wide outside the quarter-pole and capitulated. PERFECT TRIPPI was sent hard from the start, moved up between rivals, pressed the fast pace on the outside, vied three then four wide on the turn, dropped back outside the quarter-pole and faded.
