Footnotes

BRIDGETTA contently kept a watchful eye on the pacesetter three wide, ranged up when ready late on the turn and took charge before entering the stretch, took off and extended the advantage after being asked for run, leaving the eighth pole with her biggest lead, held a healthy margin to the end, kept to a drive. ESTHERS CLASSY LAS broke outward slightly making light contact with DONTRAINONMPARADE a few strides out of the starting gate, raced four wide for most of the way around the turn, finished well belatedly to garner the place. CARROT THIEF took the inside route, got asked for run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, made an abbreviated bid cutting the corner into the lane, fell back as soon as the winner was set down herself, vacated the inside in midstretch, got outfinished. AZASECRET imitated the runner up by also breaking a bit to the outside, was grabbed hold and pulled off the nearest opponent at the time before any contact could be made, grabbed the lead soon afterwards and edged away from the competition, showed the way being rated in the two path, got pounced upon by the winner approaching the quarter pole, feebly relinquished and faltered. KELLSTER got away slowly, was urged while angling three wide at the midway point on turn, failed to menace. DONTRAINONMPARADE bumped lightly just after the start, was outrun. SUCRE on the rail down the backstretch, raced along the outside on the turn, displayed only brief foot.
