SALLY'S DREAM tracked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure on the far turn, drew even with FRIVOLOUS ALEX while under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, battled with that rival on the outside, found an extra gear when switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and proved best while finishing strongly. FOREVER VOW settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, chased under a left-handed whip, loomed a threat in the final furlong and finished with good courage to get the place while unable to get to the winner. LITTLE RED RIDER settled in the back half of the field while on the inside, was roused on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, angled out under a drive near the three-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker and finished with good energy to just miss the place. FRIVOLOUS ALEX was asked from the start, went to the front, was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, came under pressure on the far turn, was set down after turning into the stretch, battled with the winner until near the sixteenth-pole and weakened. KATY'S OFFICE GIRL was taken back early, lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground, was ridden along on the far turn and improved position. AUDINGTON went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked leaving the backstretch, raced off the hedge on the far turn and came up empty. GRISAILLE was the first of three to break through the gate prior to the start, settled off the pace while off the inside, came under urging outside the seven-sixteenths pole, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SKIPS PROSPECT smashed through the front of the gate prior to the start, settled towards the rear while between rivals most of the time, came under urging on the far turn and failed to respond. ZEENUT broke through the gate prior to the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was urged along while outside on the backstretch, came under a strong ride near the half-mile pole and

faltered.
