ISN'TLOVEJUSTGRAND brushed lightly at the start with I AIN'T NO SAINT, was a bit keen early on unsettled and pulling on the bit, settled more professionally once taken from behind cover to face the breeze into the turn, came under encouragement nearing the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, displaced the leader a sixteenth out displaying a good kick while kept busy to the end to prevail. CHERNOBYL'S HERO midpack two to three wide, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, spun five wide in upper stretch, kicked home with good energy through the lane unable to reel in the top one before the line while garnering the place honors. SAINTS ALIVE duelled from the two path for command from the get go nose to nose the quieter handled of the pace combatants early on, was set down as the pressure in behind intensified at the quarter pole, edged away in upper stretch, was caught, yielding the lead at the sixteenth pole, kept on to hold readily for the show. SILVER TIMBER just off the pace chasing along the inside, came under a drive just past the five-sixteenths, cornered from the two path into the stretch, offered up a mild bid while being out kicked through the stretch by the top trio. LUIGI P three wide towards the rear, was ridden along from the three-eighths pole, swung widest six wide in upper stretch, rallied, passing tired rivals through the stretch. BEAR HEART chased the pace from the one and one early on before shifting to the three path at the three-eighths, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the quarter pole, remained in contention until the final furlong before weakening late on. CORONATION DAY fractious in the gate just prior to the start, was steadied early on down the backside, chased the front from towards the rear while two to three wide in the turn and

made no impact. I AIN'T NO SAINT brushed lightly at the start with the eventual winner being taken in hand briefly and lightly, was outrun early on chasing from just off the inside, swung three wide for home and never reached contention. FRENCH FURY broke out at the start being corrected before any contact could be made with his outside rival, dueled inside the more actively hand urged along of the pair, succumbed the front nearing the three-eighths, cut the corner into the stretch roused and gave way.
