TURBULENT DESCENT bumped with NICOLE H at the start, settled on the outside of two rivals in the second flight, ranged up in unison with NICOLE H while three wide on the turn, gained a short lead at the top of the stretch, edged clear when asked shortly thereafter, was given one crack of a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker and maintained a safe advantage while being shown the whip. DERWIN'S STAR settled towards the back, moved closer while two then three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, came under vigorous left hand urging, pursued the winner into the final furlong, chased that rival on the outside, was switched to a right-handed whip just inside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the place. ALL DUE RESPECT easily took the lead, set the clear pace through sensible fractions, vied inside on the turn, was asked when threatened by TURBULENT DESCENT and NICÓLE H near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, dropped behind the winner while under a right-handed whip and was outfinished but kept on well to get the show. BELLE OF THE HALL broke out at the start then bumped lightly with NICOLE H, was eased back off the pace, dropped well behind, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail while ridden along, made her way to the three path near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip and finished with late energy. NICOLE H broke out then bumped with rivals on both sides, settled between horses in the second flight, ranged up in unison with the winner while off the rail on the turn, made a bid between rivals at the top of the stretch, failed to match strides with TURBULENT DESCENT when that rival moved clear then gave way. ISLAND BOUND settled on the inside of two rivals in the second flight, dropped back while inside on the turn and came up empty.
