Footnotes

LAUGHING (IRE) out broke the field, was put a good hold and maintained the advantage, rating kindly, with PIANIST patiently keeping watch parked to her outside, had the rival increase her presence upon departing the backstretch, raced heads apart with that foe most of the way on the far turn, slightly hand urged to maintain interest, turned for home with the runner up still on nearly even terms, was almost at the three-sixteenths marker when asked for run, as was the chief nemesis, clung with fortitude to a slim advantage the rest of the way to the finish line to prove best. PIANIST away in good order, as was the entire field, took up position slightly to the winner's outside, was kept under a firm hold by the pilot while accompanying the top one, got let out a notch after reaching the far turn and instantly ranged up to draw abreast of the leader, remained so spinning into the stretch, got called upon nearing the three-sixteenths pole, fought with vigor but got denied by a gutsy rival and had to settle for being second best. HARD NOT TO LIKE forwardly placed three wide off the front runners, was already some encouragement during the later stages of the run on the second bend, proved no match. HUNGRY ISLAND unhurried in the two path for nearly three-quarters, commenced the strong three wide, had no rally. SOMALI LEMONADE well reserved while off the inside during the opening stages, tipped into the three path nearing the end of the backstretch, was under a drive coming four wide into the stretch, made no headway. MIZ IDA saved ground for six furlongs, was on the move outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole getting fanned into the five path by the end of the maneuver, made no impact. EMBARR strung out three wide on the opening bend, was a bit closer to the rail on the subsequent one, swung about six wide, the widest of all, into the stretch, came up empty. CENTRE COURT rated unkindly right from the get-go, fighting on the bit against the hold being used by the pilot, was guided over to the rail near the top of the second bend, faltered.
