STAKES Foxwoods King's Bishop S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Amsterdam and the Foxwoods King's Bishop or has placed in a graded sweepstake will have their entry fee waived for the Foxwoods King's Bishop. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2013, or a Grade 2 twice in 2013 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 1 or Grade 2, 4 lbs.; A graded sweepstake, or three races, 6 lbs.

(Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 10, 2013 with 25 Nominations.

Footnotes

CAPO BASTONE lacked early speed while ridden along, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, shifted three wide into the stretch, advanced between rivals passing the three-sixteenths, rallied under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip, drifted out some nearing the sixteenth-pole, was straightened by the rider, closed with a rush on the outside and stormed by the runner-up late to win going away. MENTOR CANE chased the early pace inside the early pacesetter, drew even with the leader just inside the five-eighths pole, vied along the rail on the turn, inched clear

passing the five-sixteenths pole, drew off under a drive in upper stretch, opened up a sizeable advantage into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. CENTRAL BANKER moved in while ridden along near the five-eighths pole, raced off the rail on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch while under the whip and got up for the show. FORTY TALES was void of speed, raced off the rail early on the turn, moved to four wide late on the bend, swung six wide into the stretch, steadied while caught behind tiring rivals at that point, altered course to the inside near the three-sixteenths and improved position without threatening. OVERANALYZE was ridden along towards the rear, went four wide on the turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and failed to threaten while racing near the middle of the track. SLAN ABHAILE was urged along while just off the pace, went three then four wide early on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and tired. SALUTOS AMIGOS was hustled from the start then ridden along on the inside, dropped back outside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and failed to respond. MIRACULOUSMO moved in while ridden along towards the back, went three wide on the turn, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. MAJESTIC HUSSAR was urged along while just off the pace, chased inside on the turn, came out and bumped with a rival at the top of the stretch and weakened. NO DISTINCTION chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was bumped at the top of the stretch and came up empty. BAD HOMBRE was urged along in the middle of the field, went three to four wide on the turn, floated six wide into the stretch and had nothing left. INTEGRITY was coaxed along while just off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, floated four wide near the three-eighths pole, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. LET EM SHINE disputed the pace on the outside, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. DECLAN'S WARRIOR dropped well behind the field while urged along and was eased but walked off.
