GRAHAMANDWITHERS broke on top and maintained control, cut the pace, being rated on a loosely-contested lead, drifted into the two path coming into the stretch and got set down, widened the advantage during the ensuing furlong, was kept to a steady right handed whip before being switched over entirely to a brisk hand in the final seventy yards, remained safely in front despite drifting out slightly right near the wire. SUN WORSHIPPER rated in the two path while prompting the winner from the two path, failed to keep pace with that foe after entering the stretch, managed to salvage second. HUDSON MIRACLE strung out in the four path on the opening bend, was considerably closer to the hedge for most of the way around the next one, tipped back into the four path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, swung about as wide into the lane and took off in earnest after the front runners, closed with good belatedly energy only to miss out on place honors. BIRCHWOOD ROAD within striking distance in the three path around both turns, was put to encouragement challenging the leader as the field headed into the stretch, wasn't up to the task and had to settle for the final major slice of the pot. ELROI bumped from between rivals at the start, gave chase from the two path, had no rally. POST PATTERN tracked the front runners while saving ground, was pulling on the bit with noticeable force throughout the running, angled out with a sixteenth to go, made no impact. CAMPOGIOVANNI three wide on the opening bend, remained off the inside at all times, was already under encouragement spinning six wide, the widest of all, into the stretch, lacked the needed response. IRISH JADE bumped and knocked slightly sideways at the break, was put to urging swinging five wide into upper stretch, had no rally. POLARIS DREAM quickly guided over to the rail after the start, faltered off the subsequent ground-saving journey. WINAMEN threw a fit prior to being loaded into the starting gate, broke inward, bumping into ELROI who in turn made contact with IRISH JADE, was rank under restraint nearing the end of the homestretch, sputtered five wide into the first turn, trailed while well off the rail and well off the others thereafter, arrived at the quarter pole having been put to a protective hold and was eased.
