Footnotes

ADIRONDACK DANCER was asked from the start, contested the pace on the inside, shook clear when asked into upper stretch, drifted out a bit while under a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth, drifted out significantly late and just held under continued right-hand urging. WILD BILLUM raced inside on the first turn, came off the hedge entering the backstretch, dragged his way closer with five furlongs to run, was asked while two to three wide on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside under a right-handed whip, switched to a left-handed whip while chasing the winner into the final sixteenth, was carried out while gaining late and just missed. WILDCATTER tracked the pace while in hand on the outside,

moved out some near the five-eighths pole, continued to track on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, turned into the stretch under a drive, chased under the whip into the final furlong and was outkicked while able to get the show. RIVENDELL was well placed on the inside, dropped back under urging on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. HAPPY FELLA bobbed at the break, moved in near the back, settled on the inside, moved closer with five furlongs to run, was coaxed along while inside on the far turn, came under a drive along the hedge in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. MORE HUNDRED ACRE became rank nearing the first turn, continued rank while off the hedge through that bend, was reserved off the pace, leveled out some midway down the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came under an all out drive in upper stretch, was steered in to avoid the tiring STALLWALKIN' DUDE coming to the sixteenth-pole, came between horses then brushed with a rival and failed to rally. BLUEGRASS SPRINGS went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused while inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide late on that bend and failed to threaten. ONE GOLDEN ROAD raced off the hedge on the first turn, was carried out near the five-eighths pole, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, shifted five wide into the stretch and came up empty. STALLWALKIN' DUDE raced off the hedge on the first turn, came out near the five-eighths pole, disputed the pace while well out in the course, dropped in leaving the backstretch, vied off the hedge on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. POSSE ATTACK went three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and never reached contention. CRAVING CARATS saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while off the hedge on the far turn and failed to respond. RAPID BURN raced off the hedge on the first turn, was carried out near the five-eighths pole, settled off the pace, was ridden along while five wide on the far turn and had nothing left.
