CHIEF SEATTLE broke alertly and was quickly in front, set a strong pace while in hand, drew away when asked for run and was wrapped up under the wire. KING'S MESSENGER was hustled along inside, raced just off the inner railing and finished gamely to earn the place. G' MORNING GOVENOR was hustled along outside, raced four wide and finished with good courage. ROGUES ROAD, hustled along early, finished well despite being in tight quarters along the rail in the stretch. NEVADA STRIP chased the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. CREDIT INDEED lacked a rally. FARLEY HILL raced outside and tired. LAW REVIEW raced far back early while racing very greenly and was going well after the fact. KING'S QUEST chased the winner into the stretch and tired.
