

BADOUIZM, within striking distance while under wraps, advanced three wide on the second turn, responded when set down for the drive and bested CONFESSIONAL after a long struggle. CONFESSIONAL quickly showed in front, set a strong pace along the inside, dug in gamely in the stretch and fought it out gamely to the finish. EMANATING, rated along early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and stayed on gamely to the wire. PICO TENERIFFE, close up inside while in hand, saved ground into the stretch and stayed on well inside. WEST TO EAST raced close up between rivals and had no response when roused. GRACIOUS PLENTY (IRE) hit the gate at the start and her rider lost an iron then dropped far back and was unable to recover. GIMMEAKISSEE chased the pace from the outside and tired after the opening three quarters. UNBRIDLED WIND, outrun early, had no response when roused.
