SOVEREIGN SALUTE stumbled badly at the start, rushed up along the rail, raced up close along the inside to the turn, angled out approaching the quarter pole, surged to the front in midstretch then turned back PERT REPLY under brisk urging. PERT REPLY settled in good position along the inside, rallied along the rail leaving the quarter pole, made a run inside the winner to challenge in midstretch but couldn't get by that one while holding well for the place. ONE LAST CHANCE raced in traffic between horses along the backstretch, angled five wide leaving the turn, moved between horses in upper stretch then rallied belatedly. SAFARI outsprinted rivals for the early advantage, set the early pace under pressure, opening a clear advantage on the turn, continued on the front into upper stretch then weakened from his early efforts. FOR THE FDNY HEROS bumped at the start, was unhurried along the backstretch, rallied four wide to reach contention entering the stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. YOURSTOCOMMAND raced in traffic along the inside at the half mile pole, settled just behind the leaders to the turn then lacked a strong closing response. JUST BAGIN IT never reached contention. TRADING HOURS prompted the pace while three wide into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. HUNTER'S TALE fractious in the gate prior to the start, never reached contention after breaking slowly. BOLD CONNECTION was never a factor while racing wide. TRI DIPLOMACY bumped at the start, raced up close along the backstretch then gave way on the turn. PERSONAL CASE trailed throughout.
