SMOKEY GLACKEN moved through along the rail to gain the lead at the half mile pole, extended her advantage leaving the turn then drew off under steady left hand encouragement. STORM FLEET raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground, closed the gap leaving the turn, but was no match for the winner while finishing willingly for the place. MYSTIFIED settled just off the early pace, angled out on the turn, advanced four wide into the stretch then closed late to gain a share. CABO DE NOCHE raced within striking distance while four wide to the top of the stretch and finished evenly. CHERRY'S HUNTER raced well back for a half, altered course to the inside in upper stretch then rallied belatedly along the rail. HIGHGATE PARK chased the leaders while four wide into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. TUESDAY PRAYER failed to menace after breaking slowly. BOOT STRAP pressed the pace outside the winner for a half and tired. SHOUT never reached contention. BOSTON SONG lost contact with the field while racing greenly and was never close thereafter.
