QUICK AND EASY steadied at the start and dropped back in the early stages, saved ground while rallying into the stretch, angled out nearing the furlong marker then finished with a flourish to get in the final strides. FAHRENHEIT WILD pressed the pace from outside into upper stretch, surged to the front in midstretch, led into deep stretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. GOOD CHANCE was unhurried for a half, swung four wide entering the stretch then closed late to gain a share. HUGE CITY broke in the air a bit at the start, rushed up inside, dueled along the rail into midstretch and weakened. TIME PIECE broke slowly, trailed into upper stretch and passed only tiring horses. BELLBOTTOM JOHNNY saved ground while just behind the leaders to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. LIGHTS OF BROADWAY steadied while breaking inward at the start and failed to threaten thereafter.
