FLEET INDIAN opened a clear advantage while angling to the inside on the first turn, set a moderate pace in hand for six furlongs, maintained a clear lead while under wraps on the turn, shook off a mild bid from BALLETTTO when turned loose leaving the quarter pole then drew away with authority under mild right hand encouragement. BALLETTTO (UAE) settled just off the early pace, moved out entering the backstretch, was unhurried while three wide for seven furlongs, took up chase after the winner leaving the three-eighths pole, was hard ridden to close the gap a bit approaching the top of the stretch, but was no match for FLEET INDIAN while continuing on well to clearly best the others. SOUL SEARCH was pinched back in tight quarters at the start, trailed while saving ground for seven furlongs, lodged a mild rally along the inside on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. YOLANDA B. TOO stumbled badly at the start then was taken in hand in the early stages, angled outside the winner on the first turn, stalked the pace from outside to the far turn, dropped back midway on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. INDIA HALO (ARG) checked slightly between horses while being crowded soon after the start and never reached contention.
