**Footnotes**

GOT THE LAST LAUGH broke outward causing a bit of crowding at the start, settled in good position while saving ground through the first turn, raced in midpack along the inside for five furlongs, moved out to launch his bid on the turn, rapidly gained while four wide at the quarter pole, drifted out in upper stretch, surged to the front a furlong out then edged clear under steady urging. BROADWAY PRODUCER was outrun for a half after being bumped and pinched back at the start, lodged a rally four wide leaving the turn then closed strongly between horses but could not get up. TIVERTON, never far back, pressed the pace in the two path to the top of the stretch, gained a brief lead between horses in upper stretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded late. LOCONIA raced in close contention while saving ground, moved between horses on the turn, dropped back a bit in upper stretch, lodged a bid leaving the furlong marker then steadied in traffic inside the runner-up in the late stages. SANTA'S GOLD was unhurried for five furlongs between horses, angled three wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. DANCING FOREVER was bumped and pinched back at the start and was never close thereafter. MATHEMATICIAN (IRE) set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, bobbled after taking an awkward step in upper stretch and tired from his early efforts. GAELIC STORM raced within striking distance while four wide for six furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. MENACING raced between horses throughout and lacked the needed response when called upon.
