A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box, \$1,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. DIRT Weights: Three year olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2006-07 allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 on the dirt in 2006-07, 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs.; three races on the dirt, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 11, 2007 with 31 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.)

Footnotes

SHAKIS (IRE) tucked in along the rail on the first turn, settled in good position while saving ground, waited patiently along the hedge on the turn, got through a narrow opening along the inside in upper stretch, accelerated to the front leaving the furlong marker and drew clear while being kept to the task. BIG PRAIRIE was outrun for six furlongs, rallied along the rail on the turn, swung out in upper stretch, split rivals while gaining in midstretch and finished with good energy to narrowly gain the place. DRUM MAJOR raced in midpack between horses, angled three wide on the turn then rallied belatedly from outside. BALLAST (IRE) sprinted clear early, set the pace along the inside for six furlongs, dug in when challenged on the turn, battled heads apart into midstretch and weakened late. COSMONAUT prompted the pace between horses along the backstretch, lodged a bid from outside nearing the quarter pole, but couldn't sustain his rally. WOODLANDER was outrun for six furlongs, drifted out in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. STAY CLOSE (GB) bobbled at the start, raced in midpack between horses to the top of the stretch and finished evenly. SILVER WHISTLE bobbled at the start, failed to mount a serious rally while four wide throughout. LINDA'S LAD (GB) trailed for most of the trip after breaking slowly. GUN SALUTE stalked four wide for seven furlongs and gave way.
