Footnotes

STREET SENSE moved up from outside going into the first turn, raced in hand while stalking the leaders along the backstretch, launched a bid three wide leaving the far turn, closed the gap from outside while remaining in hand approaching the quarter pole, drew along side GRASSHOPPER to challenge in upper stretch, battled heads apart outside that rival into midstretch, surged to the front under strong right hand urging to take the lead nearing the sixteenth pole then edged away a bit while switched to the left hand whip in the final seventy yards. GRASSHOPPER angled to the rail after taking the lead on the first turn, set the pace under pressure for seven furlongs, dug in when challenged by the winner in upper stretch, battled gamely along the inside into deep stretch before yielding grudgingly. HELSINKI raced far back for six furlongs, advanced inside on the turn, swung wide in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. SIGHTSEEING was unhurried for six furlongs while between horses, split horses while gaining slightly in upper stretch, bumped with LOOSE LEAF and lacked a strong closing response. C P WEST checked slightly and angled outside the pacesetter leaving the first turn, pressed the pace between horses to the far turn and drifted out while tiring in the stretch. LOOSE LEAF stalked four wide along the backstretch, lodged a mild outside bid on the turn, bumped with SIGHTSEEING and stumbled at the three-sixteenths pole then gave way. FOR YOU REppo saved ground to the turn, gave way and was eased late.
