Footnotes

KNOCKHER OFF got off last by a half beat after getting bumped by IRISH ETIQUETTE, advanced into a prominent position by the end of the backstretch, kept watch on the pacesetter from the three path, moved up when ready leaving the five-sixteenths pole and powered his way to the front to lead the field into the lane, drew well clear, under a light drive before completing the final seventy yards, wrapped up. SAYAPRAYERFORME came out at the break, resulting in each of the rivals to his outside to be either pushed outward or voluntarily shy to the outside during the very earliest stage, shook free of the others before reaching the half mile pole and was sent over to the rail, proved no match when challenged for command by the top one nearing the end of the bend, fell father and father back from that opponent, then just had enough at the end to salvage second. HAMMERHEAD was steadied when squeezed back shortly after the start, made it over to the rail by the end of the backstretch, commenced to rally when put to a drive entering the stretch, vacated the inside route with about a sixteenth remaining, missed out on place honors. ACIGARISJUSTACIGAR shied outward a few strides after the start, reacting to pressure coming from the inside initiated by the runner up, gave chase from the two path on the turn, fanned five wide into the lane, showed some belatedly foot, although never posing a threat for an in-the-money award. KITSTRICKORTREAT was allowed to shy outward shortly after the start, raced primarily from the two path on the bend, was four wide by the top of the lane, rallied mildly to mainly improve position. SOLENGO brushed at the break, stalked the pacesetter from the pocket, needed a drive by the five-sixteenths pole to keep pace, faltered. IRISH ETIQUETTE came in the start, bumping with the winner, chased the pacesetter from near the two path, was under some hand urging leaving the midway point on the turn, tired. ANIMAL WRIGHTS taken slightly wider after the start, dashed over to the rail soon afterwards, was no factor. ITS WHAT I DO pushed to the outside by an errant SAYAPRAYERFORME, departed the backstretch from the three path, bobbed after taking a bad step a sixteenth later, fell back slightly losing position to the eventual winner, continued his pursuit now being in the four path at the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
