WHAT THE FROST on the pace initially just off the inside in hand while under a tepid prompt from the outside, took to the rail into the far turn, came under light coaxing at the five-sixteenths as the pressure in behind intensified, got set down swinging two to three wide for home, shook clear to the eighth pole, dug in to maintain the advantage kept to task to the wire. ALL MINE TONIGHT squeezed back between foes at the start in hand briefly when rivals broke towards her from each side, ranged up a bit eager early down the backside to settle just off the pace two to three wide into the turn, got coaxed along at the five-sixteenths in behind the front pair, got set down swinging four wide for home, rallied willingly through the lane unable to reel in the top one while safely garnering the place. MADAME PROSECUTOR two to three wide applying tepid pressure on the leader while in hand, got let out nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide into upper stretch, kicked on mildly through the lane shying in from strong off sided stick work a sixteenth out and kept on mildly for the show honors. NECESSARY LUXURY broke in at the start squeezing out ALL MINE TONIGHT in tandem with GEE LINZ, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. OUR DAY IN COURT three wide in mid pack, shifted to the rail at the seven-sixteenths, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. MAXANA saved ground towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and made no impact. GEE LINZ broke in at the start squeezing out ALL MINE TONIGHT in tandem with NECESSARY LUXURY, raced three wide within aim of the front under light coaxing, came under further encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung five to six wide into upper stretch, was in the midst of weakening when taking a bad step or two in the final eighth and was placed to a protective hold to the wire. AGILION off the inside early on towards the rear, got urged along three to four wide through the turn

and made no impact. ZEKES SURPRISE forwardly placed four to five wide early on, chased four wide through the turn, got set down at the five-sixteenths, faded through to the quarter pole and tired in the drive. CONCEALED three to four wide towards the rear, got ridden along from three furlongs out and offered little.
