**Footnotes**

UNCOMMON VALOR was outrun early, came widest approaching the stretch, finished determinedly from the far outside and was up in the final strides, driving. FAMOUS AGAIN raced close up outside, rallied wide, reached the front inside the eighth pole and continued on gamely to the finish, just missing. SMOKIN COHIBA was rated along early, rallied wide and finished gamely outside. HEARTS AT RISK was rated inside, was steadied on the turn and again in traffic in the stretch then finished gamely. SHUT OUT TIME contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. STORM DAY rallied inside nearing the stretch and finished well despite being struck by a rival's whip in deep stretch. HUNTER PEAK contested the pace while four wide and tired in the final furlong. DECADE chased the pace along the inside and had no rally. PEAK DANCER raced close up inside, hit the rail entering the turn, put in a run along the rail turning for home and tired in the final furlong. SECURITY RISK contested the pace while between rivals three wide and tired in the stretch. SPLENDEED raced close up outside, put in a five wide run approaching the stretch and tired in the drive. REIGN OF THUNDER contested the pace while between rivals and tired after a half mile.
