Footnotes

UNSHADED was pinched back slightly at the start, raced well back while unhurried for five furlongs, rapidly gained leaving the far turn, split horses to reach contention nearing the quarter pole, moved outside the leader to threaten at the top of the stretch then, gained gradually under left hand urging through the lane and wore down ALBERT THE GREAT in the final seventy yards. ALBERT THE GREAT was carried five wide going into the first turn, forced the pace from outside along the backstretch, surged to the front gaining a slim lead on the far turn, dug in when challenged at the top of the stretch, fought gamely along the inside into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. COMMENDABLE rushed up to gain the early advantage, went four wide going into the first turn, set the pace while racing out from the rail along the backstretch, relinquished the lead nearing the half mile pole, remained a factor into upper stretch then weakened from his early efforts. DIXIE UNION steadied in tight between horses in the early stages, angled to the inside on the first turn, raced just off the pace while saving ground for seven furlongs, made a run to challenge on the far turn, battled along the inside to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. IMPEACHMENT trailed to the turn while racing wide, continued wide advancing into the stretch and failed to threaten while improving his position. POSTPONED outrun early, never reached contention. MILWAUKEE BREW was rated just off the pace while five wide for six furlongs, continued wide on the turn then steadily tired thereafter. COUNTRY COAST raced well back early, drifted out in upper stretch then failed to menace while continuing to drift out through the lane. CURULE raced up close while in hand for five furlongs, lodged a mild bid while five wide on the turn then flattened out.
