MADAME DIVA was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside, drew away when roused and widened while being kept to the task to the finish. PLEASANT LAUGHTER showed good speed along the inside, rallied nearing the stretch, proved no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. SAINT KRIS was outrun early, came four wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. QUAIL RUN chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. LITTLEBITOFLOVE was bumped after the start, raced wide throughout and had no rally. MIZLALA was steadied after the start, stumbled, raced inside and tired. GLASGOW raced three wide and had no response when roused. SCORE hit the gate at the start, was bumped, raced wide and tired. SLEW OF COLOUR tired after a half mile.
