ADIEU broke alertly, raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, dug in determinedly when set down and was clear under the wire, driving. FOLKLORE raced close up early along the inside, came wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely outside but could not get to the winner. ALONG THE SEA was bumped at the start, raced close up while three wide and had no rally. SENSATION was outrun early, raced wide throughout and had no response when roused. EFFECTUAL stumbled at the start, bumping with ALONG AT SEA, then was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. WONDER LADY ANNE L was steadied along the inside on the backstretch and had no response when roused. FIFTH AVENUE was hustled along between rivals, had no response when roused and tired.
