BERNARDINI moved up between horses to take the lead while in hand entering the first turn, set the pace under mild pressure while slightly off the rail along the the backstretch, dug in when challenged by BLUEGRASS CAT midway on the turn, opened a comfortable advantage in upper stretch, extended his lead when tapped once with the left hand whip leaving the furlong marker then drew away under confident handling through the final sixteenth. BLUEGRASS CAT moved up from outside to engage the early leaders, stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs, took a run outside the winner to threaten midway on the turn, lodged another mild bid from outside at the quarter pole but was no match for BERNARDINI while clearly best of the others. DR. PLEASURE checked after being pinched back at the start, was unhurried for six furlongs, moved between horses to launch his bid leaving the far turn, chased the leaders to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. HESANOLDSALT stumbled at the start, settled in good position for a half, angled four wide along the backstretch, closed the gap a bit from outside on the far turn, remained a factor to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. HIGH COTTON raced in close contention along the inside for seven furlongs, swung out on the turn and lacked a further response. MINISTER'S BID fractious in the gate prior to the start, checked while being pinched back at the start then trailed throughout while saving ground.
