Footnotes

CLASSIC CAMPAIGN settled in good position while saving ground, angled out on the far turn, waited just behind the leaders on the turn, swung four wide entering the stretch, charged to the front in midstretch and edged clear under a vigorous hand ride. WILLARD STRAIGHT in hand early, trailed while saving ground to the top of the stretch, angled between horses in upper stretch and finished fastest but could not get up. DEFER was under a firm hold in the early stages, raced just behind the leaders while three wide along the backstretch, cut into the leader's margin from outside on the turn, made a run to challenge briefly in midstretch then weakened late. ROUSING VICTORY was unhurried for a half after breaking a step slowly, raced three wide to the turn and failed to threaten with a mild late rally from outside. L'OISEAU D'ARGENT sprinted clear early, opened a wide gap along the backstretch, maintained a clear lead along the inside to the turn then tired from his early efforts. LORD ROBYN raced behind the pacesetter while saving ground to the turn and steadily tired thereafter.
