INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. DIRT Weights: Three year olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2005-06 allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 on the dirt in 2005-06; or four races on the dirt, 4 lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt, 6 lbs.; three races on the dirt, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 12, 2006 with 25 Nominations.

Footnotes

MY TYPHOON (IRE) angled to the rail after taking the lead nearing the first turn, set the pace in hand along the backstretch, set a moderate pace to the far turn, shook loose in upper stretch, opened a comfortable advantage in midstretch, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and held off KAREN'S CAPER under good handling. KAREN'S CAPER broke inward at the start, settled in good position for five furlongs, took up chase after the leaders while three wide leaving the turn then closed steadily through the stretch but could not get up. ASI SIEMPRE was unhurried for six furlongs, saved ground in traffic behind horses midway on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch then finished willingly to gain a share. SWEET TALKER raced in close contention along the rail while in hand for five furlongs, saved ground to the turn then lacked the needed response when called upon. SIXTY ROCKETTS raced well back for six furlongs, stayed to the inside leaving the turn and lacked a strong closing response. OZONE BERE (FR) steadied after the start, moved out along the backstretch, raced four wide to the top of the stretch and faded in the drive. ART FAN prompted the pace three wide to the turn and gave way.
