CARNIVAL CITY rushed up along the rail, dueled inside into upper stretch, fought gamely while drifting out in deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. NIGHTNIGHTNIGHT angled in during the early stages, contested the pace outside the winner for a half, battled heads apart leaving the sixteenth pole but could not get up. BLOWING KISSES settled just off the early pace, ranged up five wide to reach contention on the turn, lodged a mild bid in midstretch then finished evenly while drifting out late. RECEIPT ducked out at the start, raced in midpack early, steadied slightly between horses on the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing, losing bid. BACKSEAT RHYTHM raced well back in traffic, swung four wide at the quarter pole then closed late while drifting out through the final eighth. ELUSIVE LADY raced just behind the leaders in hand for a half, saved ground on the turn and lacked a late response. TATES QUEEN never reached contention. BUONA SERA pressed the early pace between horses, angled five wide at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. MISS GENERAL failed to mount a serious rally while five wide. SEEMINGLY raced wide throughout. EIGHTYFIVE S never reached contention. PHI BETA MOM lunged at the start and was pinched back, rushed up inside, steadied along the rail on the turn and was never close thereafter.
