This race includes an additional \$100,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Nominees only. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup Nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2007 or a Grade 2 twice in 2007 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2006; or a Grade 2 in 2007, 5 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake in 2006-07, 7 lbs. The winning owner to receive a trophy from the Breeders' Cup Limited. The New York Racing Association will present trophies to the winning Trainer and Jockey. Closed Saturday, August 11, 2007 with 15 Nominations.

**Footnotes**

MARYFIELD settled in good position along the inside for a half, angled out while gaining on the turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole, made a strong run from outside to challenge in midstretch, battled heads apart from outside into deep stretch and prevailed by a bob. BARONESS THATCHER stumbled at the start, rushed up in the two path to contest the early pace, dueled heads apart into upper stretch, dug in when challenged in midstretch, maintained a slim lead into deep stretch and yielded in the final jump. MIRACULOUS MISS was outrun for a half, circled five wide while gaining on the turn, exchanged bumps with BOCA GRANDE in upper stretch then closed late in the middle of the track to gain a share. BOCA GRANDE was outrun for a half, rallied between horses four wide on the turn, brushed with MIRACULOUS MISS in upper stretch then rallied belatedly. SWAP FLIPAROO bobbled at the start, raced well back in the two path for five furlongs and rallied mildly. BURMILLA stalked five wide along the backstretch, drifted very wide at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. NOTHING BUT FUN saved ground while outrun early, split horses on the turn and lacked a late response. PUSSYCAT DOLL pressed the pace inside for a half, drifted wide on the turn and faltered thereafter. INDIAN FLARE dueled along the rail to the top of the stretch and gave way and broke down after the finish. A claim of foul lodged by the rider of BOCA GRANDE against MIRACULOUS MISS for interference in upper stretch was disallowed.
