Footnotes

BOISTEROUS away in good order, settled into midpack, was unhurried between rivals for over six furlongs, began to pick up the pace when asked around the five-sixteenths pole, took off in earnest once straightened away, gained readily during the run through the furlong grounds, kept coming, wrested command shortly past the sixteenth pole and edged clear under strong handling. JADAL patiently prompted the leader from the outside under a firm hold, issued his challenge for the lead coming to the three-eighths pole, was put to a drive a sixteenth later, emerged with a comfortable advantage with a furlong to go, wasn't able to stave off the top one as that rival drew alongside, but continued on willingly to procure the place. RYVITI established command soon after the start, cut the pace towards the inside with the rider using rating tactics, offered brief resistance before yielding at the three-eighths pole, but mustered up enough energy to hold on well for the show. ZHIVAGO underwent a wide journey and finished willingly to earn the last major share. ANTRIM SHIELD became rank after being steadied off a rival's heels soon after the start, nudged YANKEE SCHOLAR outward being taken to the three path soon afterwards, continued on from there, failed to fire after being called upon in the stretch. CALL YOU IN TEN outrun early, improved position down the center of course by outkicking mainly weak and tired ones. EL PRIMERO well placed throughout the early going, was asked for a response at the five-sixteenths pole but came up empty. MACEDONIAN had no rally. YANKEE SCHOLAR three to four wide around both turns, tired. GRAND GIFT slipped off the inside approaching the quarter pole. GRAND PRIDE strung out four wide around the opening bend, failed to menace.
