VEE settled on the inside, moved closer on the far turn, shifted off the rail at the top of the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole, was put to a left-handed whip, closed fast on the outside and surged past SWEET BIBBY in the shadow of the wire. SWEET BIBBY broke out and was last away, rushed to the lead, quickly opened a sizeable advantage, controlled the action through solid fractions, saw her lead diminish on the far turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, came under right hand urging, led into the final sixteenth and was caught. J C'S QUEEN was restless in the gate, went three then two wide on the first turn, settled in third position, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. SAUCY JADE raced inside on the first turn, followed the clear leader from second, moved

closer on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, chased under left hand urging in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also lacked the needed kick then missed the show. FRONTAINE settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the inside at the top of the stretch, moved further out near the furlong marker and finished willingly. ESTERO BAY was reserved on the inside while near the back of the field, came under urging on the far turn and failed to rally. GRACE ALLEY lingered near the back of the field, raced towards the inside, was roused on the far turn and also failed to rally. SOTIQUE went three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. PINK SAND settled while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn and failed to respond. RAKEHELLISH was rank in the run up to the first turn, went three wide on that turn, was reserved on the outside, raced four wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. (Rail at 9 Feet)
