DRIVEN BY SUCCESS easily went to the lead, set the pace while in hand, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, inched clear near the furlong marker and held well under left hand urging. BE BULLISH was taken in hand then rated in third position, ranged up while three wide on the turn, was asked while four wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and finished willingly to get the place while unable to reach the winner. SMOKIN HERO brushed with SIX FLAGS at the start, prompted the pace on the inside of the winner, raced along the rail on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and was outfinished while able to get the show. SIX FLINGS brushed with SMOKIN HERO at the start, settled off the pace, was asked while off the rail on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. IBBOYEE was last away, moved out at the rear of the field, settled on the outside, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, went four wide on the turn, was put to stronger urging near the five-sixteenths pole, floated seven wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker and failed to rally.
