Footnotes

BALLYCLOUGH prompted the pacesetter from outside, issued a challenge at the quarter pole, blew past a weakening SEA SONG'S HAMMER to emerge from the furlong grounds holding a clear advantage, showed good determination departing that station to fend off the lone serious stretch threat for the decision. SANTO GATO was bumped after the start, raced along the outside under a snug hold and between rivals from the three-eighths pole until upper stretch, biding time during a search for racing room, saw the needed pathway open up in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was eagerly guided in that direction and took off in earnest after the top one, closed with good energy during the last eighth, but came up short. SHOUTOUT was carried inward a couple of paths by an errant SHOW TIME soon after the start, was grabbed hold and maneuvered out of trouble, departed from the backstretch in the three path and raced out there for most of the way around the bend, got called upon after entering the lane and came home willingly to secure the show, although never posing a danger to the top twosome. GHOST RIDE was put to some coaxing almost from the get-go, took the inside route, made a sharp three wide into the lane and rallied mildly to grab the last major award. SHOW TIME broke on top, but was quickly out sprinted for the lead, was maneuvered over to the inside soon afterwards, taking another pair along for a brief ride, underwent a three wide pursuit, backed away after turning for home. PERFECT SLAM (BRZ) tracked the front runners from the inside, crept up into a good striking position during the later stages of the run around the bend, maintained that position as best as she could, caught in a shuffle behind the now tiring former pacesetter and lacked any suitable options to swing outward for freedom, found that needed room near the eighth pole and outward off the inside, appeared to be moving willingly when caught behind rivals a sixteenth down the road, failed to regain his best stride, never fully clearing that pair. SEA SONG'S HAMMER was coaxed on the lead while showing the way from the inside, came under pressure leading the field into the stretch, succumbed. SOULTOWN was bumped after the start, making contact with the runner up from pressure initiated by SHOW TIME, was four wide at the half mile pole, tired steadily after entering the stretch.
