Footnotes

SPEEDY'S GAL saved ground while in the middle of the field on the first turn, settled a bit off the hedge, moved up under urging approaching the seven-sixteenths pole, chased inside on the final turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead in upper stretch and drew clear under strong right hand urging. STRAY BULLET looked for a way to get towards the inside on the initial straightaway, ended up three wide on the initial turn, was unhurried towards the back, moved closer while inside on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, followed MISSYSMOONLITMAGIC into the

stretch, came under a drive, advanced between rivals into the final furlong and secured the place position while no threat to the winner. MISSYSMOONLITMAGIC dropped to the inside midway through the first bend, settled on the inside, advanced nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, was urged along while inside on the far turn, moved through along the hedge into the stretch, was put to a drive while in a good striking position, failed to match strides with the winner, held the second position into the final furlong but lost that position and settled for the show. PROUDROAD TO GLORY went mostly three wide on the first turn, was reserved in the middle of the field while off the inside, came under some urging while between rivals leaving the backstretch, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn and more in hand, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. DANCIN PERFECT angled in towards the rear, was unhurried while on the inside, came under under some urging on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch, came off the inside near the furlong marker and improved position. WHO IS LADY broke very fast, was eased back when joined by combatants seeking the lead nearing the first turn, saved ground on that bend, came off the hedge while forwardly placed on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. CLASSICAL FASHION navigated around THE SILVER MACHINE when that rival bore out early on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead after straightening for the drive and gave way. NIGHT BRIGADE settled inside through the first turn, moved out on the backstretch, was hard ridden while four wide on the far turn and came up empty. CINDY'S JOY broke a bit slow, saved ground on the first turn, lingered near the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. SHE DRIVES ME WILD went two then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came under a ride outside the seven-sixteenths pole, was ridden along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. THE SILVER MACHINE showed early run, bore out entering the first turn then checked off heels, went back to a straighter course shortly thereafter, tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn and capitulated. KITTYLICIOUS lagged well back while on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn and was no factor.
