SIGN took the inside route, fighting noticeably against the bit from the left side until the three-eighths pole, was given some rein slipping into the two path at that station and went about more professionally thereafter, closed in readily on the embattled threesome just before reaching the quarter pole and bid in earnest as the widest of four by the head of the stretch, shook free and arrived at the eighth pole with none latched on, drew off impressively, being flashed the whip from the right side to counteract a tendency to drift outward in the late stages. HONOR BRIGHT was briefly hustled to grab the early advantage, saved ground while attempting to fight off another pair until the quarter pole, proved powerless to stave off the top one in upper stretch, held on with good courage though to secure second. MARCELLINA D'ORO departed the backstretch three wide, was urged along while racing around the bend, rallied well enough to get up for the show. GRACEFUL RAGE was the outermost member of three disputing the pace until upper stretch before backing away. APOLOGIZE got away a half beat slowly after lunging at the break, was hand urged to reach a good position off the pace battle before getting switched over to a snug hold by the pilot, got asked for some run once again just past the half mile pole, left the midway point on the turn having been set down, tired after turning for home. LENDEROFLASTRESORT contested the pace from between rivals for nearly a half and gave way. JET AWAY raced towards the inside and failed to reach a contending position. SEVEN DREAMS placed five wide at the top of the lane, was outrun.
