Footnotes

SCREENPLAY broke on top, took up residence in the two path and had control until midpoint down the backstretch, had RONIN DAX scurry up along the hedge and draw abreast at the five-eighths pole, dueled with that opponent from that juncture until a short distance past the three-sixteenths pole, got asked for a response for the first time at the head of the stretch, edged away, put to an intermittent right handed whip. RECHARGED took the inside route, cut the corner into the lane and made steady progress on the winner during the initial portion of the stretch run, was angled outward in midstretch for the remainder of the way home, closed in willingly to garner place honors. SR. HENRY bobbed at the start yet readily assumed a forward position, sat well placed in the two path and under a good hold for nearly three-quarters, was given his cue entering the stretch, altered course slightly to the outside midway through the furlong grounds for better racing clearance, remained a prominent factor thereafter but was outfinished late for second. FOOLISH TIGER lunged inward at

the start, was reserved while racing along the outside, lacked the necessary stretch response. RONIN DAX forwardly placed soon after the start, cruised up from the hedge to confront the top one at the five-eighths pole, argued for command with that opponent from that station until upper stretch, was the first of the two combatants to get called for some run, doing so a few strides before reaching the quarter pole, fell back steadily during the run through the furlong grounds, weakened in the last eighth. BIG SKY POSSE saved ground and was no factor. BOLD VINDICATION three wide around both turns, folded. PLEASANT RUN raced along the outside, commenced the stretch drive three wide, came up empty. MONASTIR rode the hedge until the three-eighths pole, was on the move outward, settling into the five path by the top of the lane, had little to offer. FASTEST MAGICIAN swung four wide into the stretch and was no menace.
