**Footnotes**

BEMATA rode the rail for most of the way around the turn, angled outward to take on the surviving participants of the pace dispute heading into the stretch, wrested away the lead from DRUM ROLL near the sixteenth pole and kicked away. DRUM ROLL secured a prominent position shortly after the start, contested the pace from the three path as the widest of a threesome, had the inner member of the group leave the fight a few jumps before reaching the end of the bend, spun into the lane side by side with FLY BYE POMEROY, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before getting asked for run, won that duel to poke a head down in front with a furlong remaining, got collared by the winner a sixteenth later, continued onward willingly to secure second. BELIEF SYSTEM along the inside, was hounded by a pair parked to the outside while clinging to a narrow advantage, fell back slightly prior to quarter pole and steadily weakened thereafter. FLY BYE POMEROY disputed the pace from between rivals until nearing the quarter pole, was the second of the trio to have the rider commit to some kind of encouragement, continued the fight one on one with the runner up for an additional furlong before giving way. MISTER WOOLMAN driven five wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. PLEIADIAN underwent a two wide pursuit on the bend, was already under solid encouragement turning for home, failed to menace. THINGAMAJIGGER in the two path, gave chase on a three-way pace dispute having been put to a prolonged drive, gave way. POLIZIANO faded off a ground-saving journey.
