PLEASANT BREEZE controlled the pace while in hand, dug in gamely in the stretch then drew clear under the line under a drive and was vanned off after the finish. CATIENUS raced close up while wide and finished gamely outside. GANDER raced close up while between rivals and stayed on well along the inside. J. R. HOLMES raced close up inside while in hand, put in a run along the rail approaching the stretch and faded in the drive. KIMBERLITE PIPE was rated along outside, put in a wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. NITE DREAMER had no response when roused. LAGER raced inside and tired.
