Footnotes

MOLOKO settled just off the early pace, rallied three wide to challenge at the quarter pole, battled heads apart outside MAGGIE'S TURN into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. MAGGIE'S TURN chased the leader between horses, surged to the front nearing the quarter pole, dueled inside the winner through the stretch and yielded grudgingly. HALFWAY TO HEAVEN was reserved early while saving ground, steadied along the rail while behind horses entering the stretch, angled out while rallying inside the furlong marker then finished fastest but could not get up. PAUGUS BAY fractious in the gate prior to the start, trailed for a half after breaking slowly, saved ground leaving the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch then rallied belatedly. TRUEYTOO in hand early, lodged a mild rally four wide on the turn then steadied outside HALFWAY TO HEAVEN while weakening in he late stages. TUDOR COURT was never a factor. WON MORO stumbled at the start, raced four wide to the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. SEXUAL HARRASMENT raced up close between horses to the turn and gave way. LIFEYTHEDROP set the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch and faltered.
