CONSTANCY was unhurried early on, advanced inside on the second turn, altered course in upper stretch, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. THONG was unhurried early, rallied wide on the second turn, earned a short lead in the stretch and continued on gamely but could not handle the winner. QUICKLY NOW was outrun early, raced three wide throughout and finished well outside. STRIKE POINT raced inside and had no response when roused. TUNE UP THE BAND was outrun early, raced wide and lacked a rally. TWO SHARKY BETTY was not a factor. TRICK AGAIN stumbled at the start, was bumped after the start, ran off to a long lead and tired in the stretch. BEAUTIFUL SPY was bumped after the start, raced inside and had no rally. OPEN AND SHUT had no response when roused. STAKE chased the pace for three quarters and tired.
