PLEASANT HILL sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace along the rail for a half, shook loose in upper stretch and drew away while being ridden out. MAIZELLE was carried out by the loose horse along the backstretch, worked her way forward while four wide on the turn and closed late in the middle of the track to best the others. CAPE SUNSET raced just off the pace for a half, angled out entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. DIAMANTINA drifted in a bit along the backstretch, made a run from outside to threaten at the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. SOUTHERN SASS checked after breaking outward at the start, raced between horses along the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. FOREST STAR checked between horses nearing the far turn, raced wide to the turn and lacked a late responses. JESSAMY LANE checked and was pinched back after breaking awkwardly and failed to threaten thereafter. YDY steadied to avoid the spill along the backstretch and trailed throughout. BEMUSED clipped SOUTHERN SASS' heels and stumbled unseating the rider in the process. Following a stewards inquiry there was no change in the order of finish.
